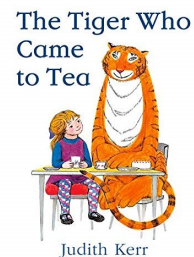
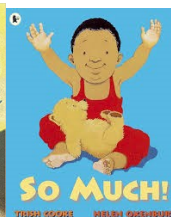
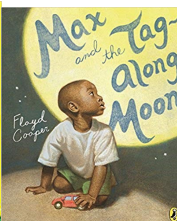
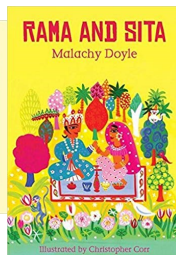
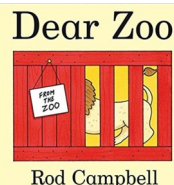
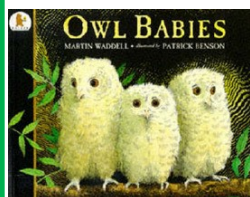
Attendance and Punctuality
